Safety Bath Inc. Sends First Container Shipment to Australia

On Wednesday, July 12, 2006, Safety Bath Inc., Saskatchewan manufacturer of accessible bathtubs, sent its first container shipment to Sydney, Australia. The container shipment was loaded at the Safety Bath production plant in Ituna, Saskatchewan, Canada by Giroux Trucking of Regina, SK on the morning of July 12. The shipment was taken to CP Rail in Regina where it was loaded to be taken by rail to Vancouver, BC and then sent on to Sydney by All Cargo Express via ocean freight. The final destination of all 20 bathtubs in the container is Safe Bath Australasia, the authorized representative for Safety Bath dealer development in Australia and New Zealand. It is expected that the shipment will reach its destination in approximately a month.

The shipment consisted of 9 Standard Safety Baths, 10 So-Lo Bathtubs and one Supreme Walk in Bathtub, for the institutional market. The Standard is the original Safety Bath compact walk in bathtub with a door. The So-Lo is the newest innovative product for accessible bathing from Safety Bath Inc. The So-Lo is a regular sized walk in bathtub with a door, designed to address the changing needs of the baby boomer generation and to answer demands in the construction industry for an accessible regular sized bathtub.

Earlier in July, Safety Bath Inc. also sent its first single Standard Safety Bath to Nautilus-Mercury in Novosibirsk, Russia, a company whose intention it is to certify the Safety Bath for use in Russia and eventually become an authorized representative.

Don Hardy, Sales Manager for Safety Bath Inc., had the following comments:

"This is a very exciting day for all of us at a Safety Bath Inc. The container shipment to Safe Bath Australasia is the result of over a year of hard work, beginning with our participation in the recently opened Canada Export Centre in Vancouver, BC. It was at the Export Centre that Adam Deeby from Sydney, AU, learned of us and our products. Adam has spent the last year creating awareness of our walk in bathtubs and developing a dealer network in Australia. The relationship with the Russian company also began through contact made at the Canada Export Centre when Sergei Proskurin, a visiting professor saw our display and initiated a deal with Nautilus Mercury of Novosibirsk.

What began as a single bathtub in 1992, to help the father of inventor Ladimer Kowalchuk, is now making its way around the world. "
